To ensure our clients feel adequately prepared for interviews, we offer comprehensive interview skills training. We cover various interview formats, including phone, video, individual, and group interviews.




Through extensive research and practice, we aim to enhance their performance and boost their confidence.

This assessment matches an individual's interests with specific careers in which others are already working. This tool helps identify areas of study that can bring clarity to career goals and lead to employment opportunities in fields that may have been previously unknown to the job seeker. We are excited to offer this service, as it can illuminate new career choices that may ultimately lead our students and graduates to meaningful and fulfilling employment pathways.

These are counseling services tailored to the needs of the individual including the Strong Interest Inventory assessment, resume editing and guidance, job search and application training, and interview preparation.
- 48% of job applications turned into interviews.
- 46% of interviews turned into job offers.
