OUR VISION



CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE)

Our CTE-focused elective program exposes students to several career pathways before allowing them the choice to specialize with deeper study in the field of their interest. The four career tracks currently include tiered courses in construction trades, health, technology for industry, and culinary/hospitality.



RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

In February of 2024, Hanna Academy launched a new residential program for students who qualify to live on campus.

The residential program offers youth who live too far away and are in need of daily assistance, the opportunity to live on campus while receiving specialized education and support. With a staff-to-student ratio of one to six, the program goes beyond school hours to provide personalized care, including recreation and case management.

RESIDENTIAL ADMISSION

To be admitted, students must have an IEP, be referred, and be accepted to Hanna Academy.

RESIDENTIAL GOALS

The program aims to facilitate change and support students as they navigate challenging transitions and develop into responsible, compassionate adults.

RESIDENTIAL DETAILS

Our residential program encompasses dorm life, health and nutrition, and counseling services.

Students experience a group living environment that fosters friendships and includes structured daily activities.

Counseling and casework services are provided to help students manage stress, resolve conflicts, heal from trauma, and improve their relationships.

We also offer sports and recreation programs to promote teamwork, physical fitness, and a healthy lifestyle.
